Philemon 2:9-10 God raised him up to the heights of heaven and gave him a name that is above every other name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Matthew 8:16-17 And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses."

John 6:63 It is the Spirit who gives eternal life. Human effort accomplishes nothing. And the very words I have spoken to you are spirit and life.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Romans 10:17 Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

1 John 4:17 As He is, so are we in this world.

Philippians 4:6-7 Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. If you do this, you will experience God's peace, which is far more wonderful than the human mind can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

Luke 4:18-19 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, for he has appointed me to preach Good News to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim that captives will be released, that the blind will see, that the downtrodden will be freed from their oppressors, and that the time of the Lord's favor has come.

Acts 2:21 Anyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

Luke 1:37 Nothing is impossible with God.

Psalms 34:10 Even strong young lions sometimes go hungry, but those who trust in the Lord will never lack any good thing.

1 John 5:14-15 And we can be confident that he will listen to us whenever we ask him for anything in line with his will. And if we know he is listening when we make our requests, we can be sure the he will give us what we ask for.

James 5:14-16 Are any among you sick? They should call for the elders of the church and have them pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord. And their prayer offered in faith will heal the sick, and the Lord will make them well. And anyone who has committed sins will be forgiven.

Matthew 10:7-8 Go and announce to them that the Kingdom of Heaven is near. Heal the sick, raise the dead, cure those with leprosy, and cast out demons. Give as freely as you have received.

Acts 1:8 But when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, you will receive power and will tell people about me everywhere...

John 16:12-15 Oh, there is so much more I want to tell you, but you can't bear it now. When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not be presenting his own ideas; he will be telling you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future. He will bring me glory by revealing to you whatever he receives from me. All the Father has is mine: this is what I mean when I say that the Spirit will reveal to you whatever he receives from me.

1 Corinthians 2:4-5 My message and my teaching were very plain. I did not use wise and persuasive speeches, but the Holy Spirit was powerful among you. I did this so that you might trust the power of God rather than human wisdom.

John 20:21-23 "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." Then he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone's sins, they are forgiven. If you refuse to forgive them, they are unforgiven."

Matthew 28:18-20 I have been given complete authority in heaven and on earth. Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.

Mark 16:15-18 Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone, everywhere. Anyone who believes and is baptized will be saved. But anyone who refuses to believe will be condemned. These signs will accompany those who believe: They will cast out demons in my name and they will speak new languages. They will be able to handle snakes with safety, and if they drink anything poisonous, it won't hurt them. They will be able to place their hands on the sick and heal them.

Psalms 119:11 I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.

Psalms 107:20 The Lord sent His word and healed them.

Acts 2:17-18 In the last days, God said, I will pour out my Spirit upon all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, and your old men will dream dreams. In those days I will pour out my Spirit upon all my servants, men and women alike, and they will prophesy.

John 14:12-14 The truth is, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, because the work of the Son brings glory to the Father. Yes, ask anything in my name, and I will do it!

Exodus 15:26 I am the Lord who heals you.

John 10:10 The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give life in all its fullness.

Galatians 5:6 What is important is faith expressing itself in love.

Mark 16:20 And the disciples went everywhere and preached, and the Lord worked with them, confirming what they said by many miraculous signs.

Psalms 78:4-7 We will not hide these truths from our children but will tell the next generation about the glorious deeds of the Lord. We will tell of his power and the mighty miracles he did. For he issued his decree to Jacob; he gave his law to Israel. He commanded our ancestors to teach them to their children, so the next generation might know them – even the children not yet born – that they in turn might teach their children. So each generation can set its hope anew on God, remembering his glorious miracles and obeying his commands.

Matthew 6:9-10 Pray like this: Our Father in heaven, may your name be honored. May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done here on earth just as it is in heaven.

Mark 11:22-24 Have faith in God. I assure you that you can say to this mountain, 'May God lift you up and throw you into the sea,' and your command will be obeyed. All that's required is that you really believe and do not doubt in your heart. Listen to me! You can pray for anything, and if you believe, you will have it. But when you are praying, first forgive anyone you are holding a grudge against, so that your Father in heaven will forgive your sins, too.

Philemon 2:13 For God is working in you, giving you the desire to obey him and the power to do what pleases him.

Matthew 16:18-19 Upon this rock I will build my church, and all the powers of hell will not conquer it. And I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven. Whatever you lock on earth will be locked in heaven, and whatever you open on earth will be opened in heaven.

John 16:9 The world's sin is unbelief in me.

Acts 2:1-4 The believers were meeting together in one place. Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm in the skies above them, and it filled the house where they were meeting. Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them. And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.

Acts 10:38 And no doubt you know that God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. Then Jesus went around doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the Devil, for God was with him.

Acts 4:29 And now, O Lord, hear their threats, and give your servants great boldness in their preaching. Send your healing power, may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of you holy servant Jesus.

Hebrews 12:1-3 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith, let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily hinders our progress. And let us run with endurance the race that God has set before us. We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, on whom our faith depends from start to finish. He was willing to die a shameful death on the cross because of the joy he knew would be his afterward.

Learn to swear and you will be a blessing!

Jeremiah 4:1-2 If you will swear by my name alone, and begin to live good, honest lives and uphold justice, then you will be a blessing to the nations of the world, and all people will come and praise my name." **It is a powerful privilege.**

Jeremiah 44:26 None of you may invoke my name or use this oath: 'As surely as the Sovereign LORD lives!'

Matthew 7:11 If you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give good gifts to those who ask him.

Matthew 8:2-3 "Lord," the man said, "if you want to, you can make me well again." Jesus touched him. "I want to," he said. "Be healed!"

Isaiah 54:17 No weapon formed against us shall prosper.

Romans 8:28 God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them.

Matthew 7:7-8 Keep on asking, and you will be given what you ask for. Keep on looking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened. For everyone who asks, receives. Everyone who seeks, finds. And the door is opened to everyone who knocks.

Ephesians 3:20 By his mighty power at work within us, he is able to accomplish infinitely more than we would ever dare to ask or hope.

Prayer for Healing 1

Interview. Determine the condition. Try to determine the cause. Name? How can I pray for you? How long? Do you know the cause?

Diagnosis. Determine the root cause. Afflicting spirit; sickness rooted in the soul (psychosomatic); or natural causes such as accident or injury. Doctor's diagnosis? Did someone cause this? Have you forgiven him/her? Did anything traumatic happen in the months before this condition began? Emotional wounds (fear, shame, rejection)?

Decide how to pray. Petition or Command. Use commands when: Breaking a curse or vow, casting out an afflicting spirit or other spirit, progress has stopped with petition prayers, the Holy Spirit leads you to, a word of knowledge or other circumstance indicates that God wants to heal the person immediately.

1 John 4:4 But you belong to God, my dear children. You have already won your fight with these false prophets, because the Spirit who lives in you is greater than the spirit who lives in the world.

Matthew 21:21-22 I assure you, if you have faith and don't doubt, you can do things like this and much more. You can even say to this mountain, 'May God lift you up and throw you into the sea,' and it will happen. If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer.

Numbers 6:22-27 The LORD said to Moses, "Tell Aaron and his sons, 'This is how you are to bless the Israelites. Say to them: ; 'The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you; The LORD turn his face toward you and give you peace.' ' "So they will put my name on the Israelites, and I will bless them."

Romans 8:31 If God is for us, who can ever be against us?

Prayer for Healing 2

Prayer Ministry. Audibly ask the Holy Spirit to be present with His guidance and His healing power. Ask the person not to pray but to close eyes and relax and focus on what is happening in their body. Just receive. To interrupt you and tell you if any change is felt. If necessary, have them confess any sin or unforgiveness and pray for emotional healing before praying for physical healing.

Keep your eyes open to see God's touch.

Follow any leading of the Holy Spirit.

Use normal tone of voice.

Always pray in the name of Jesus.

Pray into the symptoms and the cause, if the cause is know.

Use short, specific prayers.

Try different kinds of prayer.

If a specific prayer brings a change, keep using it.

Pray where God is working.

Periodically ask, "What is going on?"

Do not preach or give advice.

1 Corinthians 2:9-13 "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him." But we know these things because God has revealed them to us by his Spirit, and his Spirit searches out everything and shows us even God's deep secrets...And God has actually given us his Spirit so we can know the wonderful things God has freely given us...We speak words given to us by the Spirit, using the Spirit's words to explain spiritual truths.

Mark 13:11 But when you are arrested and stand trial, don't worry in advance about what to say. Just say what God tells you at that time, for it is not you who will be speaking, but the Holy Spirit.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 All scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Prayer for Healing 3

Remember: Trust the Holy Spirit, not the method.

Be loving! Be persistent!

Thank God for whatever He does.

You can't thank Him too much.

If pain moves or increases, consider casting out an afflicting spirit.

If you are not making progress, consider interviewing further: Try remembering any significant event? Do you have a strong fear of anything? Do you know of anyone who is angry at you? Have any family members been a member of the Freemasons? Have any family members had this same condition? Has anyone spoken a curse over you or your family? Have you ever been involved with occult or Satanic activity? Are you accident-prone?

Stop praying when: The person is healed or wants you to stop, the Holy Spirit tells you, you are making no progress and receive no other way to pray.

James 1:6-8 But when you ask him, be sure that you really expect him to answer, for a doubtful man is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind. People like that should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. They can't make up their minds. They waver back and forth in everything they do.

Romans 12:1-2 I plead with you to give your bodies to God. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice – the kind he will accept. When you think of what he has done for you, is this too much to ask for? Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will know what God wants you to do, and you will know how good and pleasing and perfect his will really is.

Romans 10:12 He generously gives his riches to all who ask for them.

1 John 4:8 But the Son of God came to destroy these works of the Devil.

Prayer for Healing 4

After prayer. Follow-up instructions and exhortations. Encourage from scripture. Encourage lifestyle changes to maintain healing and prevent recurrence.

If someone is not healed or is only partially healed, do not accuse someone of a lack of faith or of sin in their life as the cause.

Prepare them the resist any further attack after their healing.

Not everyone gets healed, but **everyone must feel loved.**

Salvation

Acts 16:31 Believe on the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, along with your entire household.

Romans 10:9 If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved.

2 Corinthians 5:17 If any man is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old is gone, the new has come!

Psalms 27:8 My heart has heard you say, "Come and talk with me" And my heart responds, "Lord, I am coming."

1 John 1:8-10 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.

Prayer for Deliverance 1

Objective: Expel demons, close doors of access to victims, enable him/her to keep the doors closed in the future.

Work as a team.

Give the individual priority. Loving and encouraging. Go to a quiet place. Invite the Holy Spirit.

If a spirit manifests, make it be quiet. "Submit in the name of Jesus!" Persistently repeat until the spirit obeys.

Establish and maintain communication with the person. You must have his/her attention and cooperation.

Ask the person what he/she wants freedom from. Make sure he/she really wants freedom from the bondage.

Confirm that the person has accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior. Lead them in prayer for salvation if necessary. If unwilling, bless them but don't try deliverance.

Prayer for Deliverance 2

Interview to discover the event(s) or relationship(s) that have led to the bondage(s). Expose where forgiveness is required and where healing, repentance, breaking of bondages are needed. Find all open doors. Be thorough and don't rush.

Parental relationships?

Body. Sexual sin. Uninvited sexual relationship. Long illness or general weakness. All addictions.

Soul. Resentment/Anger. Trauma and its effects. Rejection/Loneliness. Unforgiveness/Bitterness. Hatred. Despair/Hopelessness. Pride/Arrogance.

Rebellion/Vengeance. Fear in all forms. Criticism/Gossip. Envy in all forms. Greed.

Spirit. Any occult experience. Witchcraft/Manipulation.

Satanism/Freemasonry.

Inner

Vows? I will never/I will always.

Curses? You will never/You will always.

Isaiah 52:6 I will reveal my name to my people, and they will come to know its power.

Isaiah 52:10 The LORD will demonstrate his holy power before the eyes of all the nations. The ends of the earth will see the salvation of our God.

Isaiah 52:15 He will again startle many nations. Kings will stand speechless in his presence. For they will see what they had not previously been told about; they will understand what they had not heard about.

Isaiah 53:5 He was wounded and crushed for our sins. He was beaten that we might have peace. He was whipped, and we were healed!

Isaiah 55:11 It is the same with my word. I send it out, and it always produces fruit. It will accomplish all I want it to, and it will prosper everywhere I send it.

Prayer for Deliverance 3

Lead the person in closing the door(s) through which the spirit(s) entered.

Forgive. For hurts and/or wrong conduct. Be specific. Release the offender to God. Quietly bind the spirit of unforgiveness. If unable to forgive, pray for healing and blessing but not deliverance.

Repentance. "Father, forgive me for ____." Confess, ask forgiveness, ask for healing of soul.

Renounce. Audibly renounce all spirits and vows in the name of Jesus. "In the name of Jesus I renounce the spirits of ____ and ____." "In the name of Jesus, I renounce the vow I made never/always to ____."

Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, for he has appointed me to preach Good News to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim that captives will be released, that the blind will see, that the downtrodden will be freed from their oppressors, and that the time of the Lord's favor has come.

Revelation 2:17 Anyone who is willing to hear should listen to the Spirit and understand what the Spirit is saying to the churches. Everyone who is victorious will eat of the manna that has been hidden away in heaven.

Romans 4:17 The God who gives life to the dead and calls things that are not as though they were.

Prayer for Deliverance 4

Break the bondage(s) in the name of Jesus. This closes the door. You or the seeker can do this. "In the name of Jesus I break the power of the spirit(s) of ____ over (Fred) so that when they are cast out, they will not come back." "In the name of Jesus I break the power of every curse over (Fred) from ____ (father's careless words, fathers Freemasonry, etc.)"

Cast out the unclean spirit(s) in the name of Jesus. With all doors closed, the spirits will leave quickly and quietly. If they don't, interview for more information. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal what He wants to do next. He wants to help!

Have the person thank Jesus for his deliverance. If he/she cannot, or if spirits manifest, more doors need to be closed.

Have the person ask the Holy Spirit to fill him or her and all the places formerly occupied by the evil spirits.
